## New Student Housing Contract

Franklin Pierce University is a small, residential school committed to education both inside and outside the classroom. We believe that living in the residence facilities is a valuable component of the total educational and developmental experience of being a student. Furthermore, campus living contributes to the sense of community, which makes Franklin Pierce University the kind of institution it is today - a community of learners. Due to these institutional commitments, a student is required to reside in facilities and is encouraged to become an active participant in campus life.

All students living in residential facilities must agree to the following:

1. As a student at Franklin Pierce University, I am responsible for room and board fees as stated by the University. I also must be financially clear and deposited.
2. If residing in any of the first year or sophomore housing areas, I must participate in a board plan.
3. I must comply with all rules and regulations, and with terms and conditions governing residency, as published in the Student Handbook, Academic Catalogue, Student Code of Conduct, and other University documents.
4. The Department of Residential Life reserves the right to refuse the application for any room, cancel this contract, or require me to move whenever the best interest of the University requires such action or if I failed to meet the conditions described.
5. If I leave my residence unacceptable, the Department of Residential Life has the right to charge me for any damages as well as change my residence.
6. The University is not responsible for damages or theft to personal belongings. As such, we strongly encourage students to carry insurance through their parent's homeowner policy or through another carrier.
